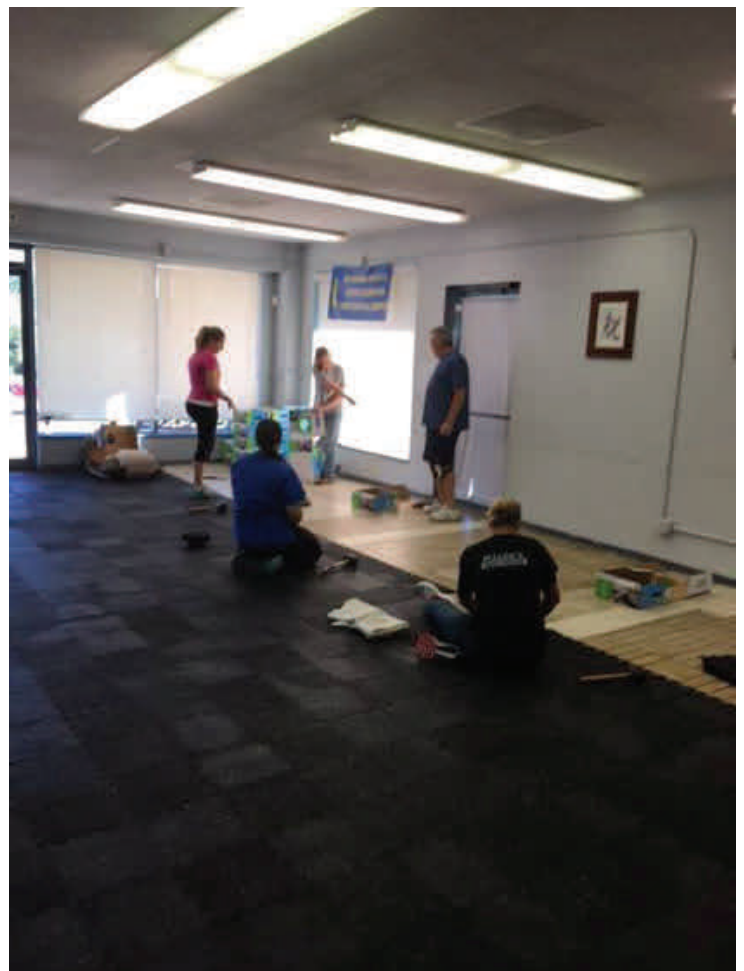
NEW MATS FOR OUR TRAINING CENTER

Thank you again for your help! It definitely wouldn't have happened without you!

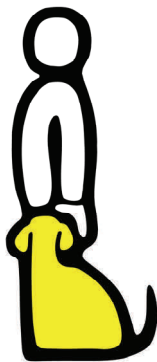

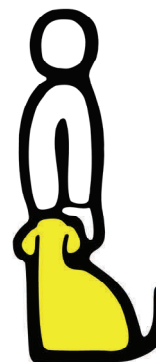
