(American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11 Section 2). An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 1st entry and \$3.00 additional entry of the same dog will be required at any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 3) These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

ALL ENTRIES must have the agreement attached to the entry form. Entries may not be accepted, cancelled or changed after the closing date and time.

CONDITIONAL ENTRIES. No entry shall be made and no entry accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

CHANGES, ADDITIONS, OR CORRECTIONS to entries and entry forms must be received in writing or by Email prior to close of entries.

NO ENTRY FEE WILL BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

NO ENTRY FEE WILL BE REFUNDED if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause which is beyond the control of the Club or the Trial Secretary.

BITCHES COMING INTO SEASON after close will receive a refund of their entry fee provided the trial secretary is notified prior to the start of the trial and written verification is provided by a veterinarian.

DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING WHEN CALLED TO THE RING. Neither the club nor any ring steward will be obliged to call or notify exhibitors of when they are due in the ring for judging. Judges are not required to wait for any dog.

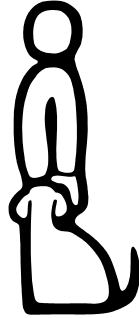

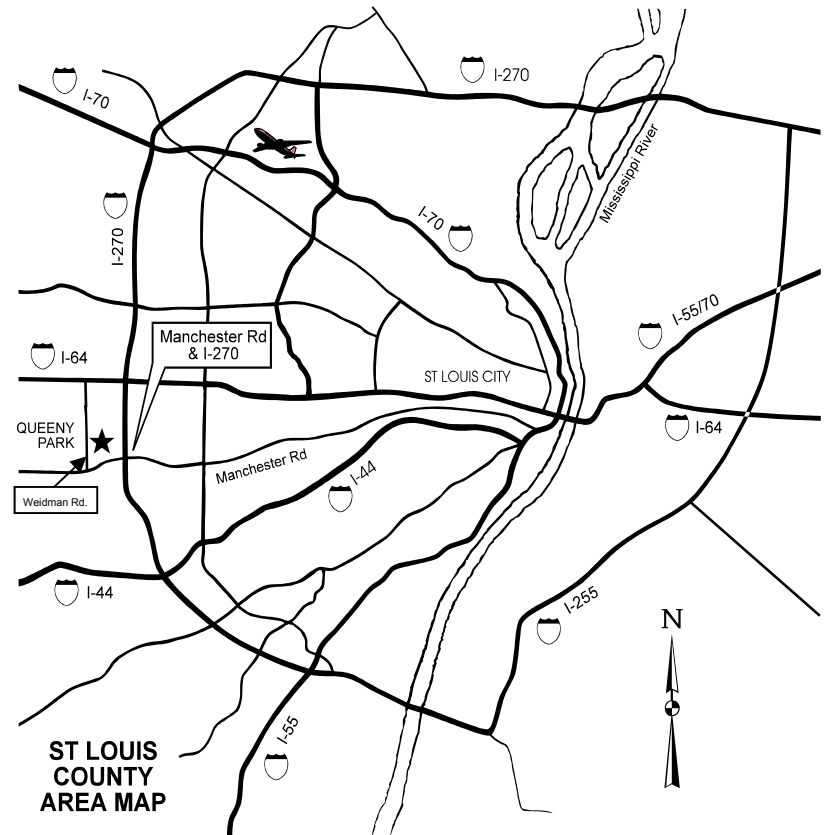
