Dogs have twice as many muscles for moving their ears as people.

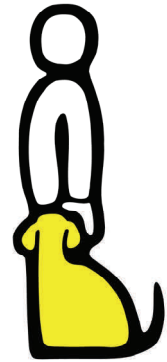
Dogs and cats turn in circles before lying down because in the wild this instinctive action turns long grass into a bed.
